It will cover cutting, transporting and grooming daylilies for the show.

We have had requests from members for a demonstration on how to divide daylilies. Since our members need to know how to divide the nesting daylilies in order to return a double fan we will have a hands on demonstration at the May 3rd meeting. Sharan Gilchrist and William Radford will be doing the dividing demonstration.

We would like to remind those returning daylilies to divide and pot them so they will be ready for sale at the June meeting. Only return the nesting daylily if it has grown enough

to return a double fan or more and keep some for yourself. The club membership will have first opportunity to purchase returned nesting daylilies at the June 7th meeting and then they will be offered for sale at the June 9th TADS Show and Sale.

The TADS Daylily H. Karen Keith is now available to the TADS membership. Those that have already ordered their plants can pick them up at the May 3rd TADS meeting. We still have some available at \$60. for a double fan. After the TADS members have been given an opportunity to purchase Karen Keith, they will be made available to the general public.
